John 4:15-29 (NASB)

¹⁵ The woman *said to Him, " Sir, give me this water, so I will not be thirsty nor come all the way here to draw." ¹⁶ He *said to her, "Go, call your husband and come here." ¹⁷ The woman answered and said, "I have no husband." Jesus *said to her, "You have correctly said, 'I have no husband'; ¹⁸ for you have had five husbands, and the one whom you now have is not your husband; this you have said truly." ¹⁹ The woman *said to Him, " Sir, I perceive that You are a prophet. ²⁰ Our fathers worshiped in this mountain, and you *people* say that in Jerusalem is the place where men ought to worship." ²¹ Jesus *said to her, "Woman, believe Me, an hour is coming when neither in this mountain nor in Jerusalem will you worship the Father. ²² You worship what you do not know; we worship what we know, for salvation is from the Jews. ²³ But an hour is coming, and now is, when the true worshipers will worship the Father in spirit and truth; for such people the Father seeks to be His worshipers. ²⁴ God is spirit, and those who worship Him must worship in spirit and truth." ²⁵ The woman *said to Him, "I know that Messiah is coming (He who is called Christ); when that One comes, He will declare all things to us." ²⁶ Jesus *said to her, " I who speak to you am *He*." ²⁷ At this point His disciples came, and they were amazed that He had been speaking with a woman, yet no one said, "What do You seek?" or, "Why do You speak with her?" ²⁸ So the woman left her waterpot, and went into the city and *said to the men, ²⁹ "Come, see a man who told me all the things that I *have* done; this is not the Christ, is it?"

1st Question in the Bible- Gen3: ⁸ They heard the sound of the LORD God walking in the garden in the cool of the day, and the man and his wife hid themselves from the presence of the LORD God among the trees of the garden. ⁹ Then the LORD God called to the man, and said to him, " Where are you?"

1st Question in the New Testament.- Matt.2: ¹ Now after Jesus was born in Bethlehem of Judea in the days of Herod the king, magi from the east arrived in Jerusalem, saying, ² "Where is He who has been born King of the Jews?"

The World Has Questions. When a non-believer finds out that you are religious, like the Samaritan woman, they will ask you questions.



It was the meeting place and the pastor was the most learned man in town. The Bible was the textbook in the school. Almost all the colleges such as: Harvard, Yale, Williams and Mary, Dartmouth were missionary schools. But now, the world is going to other sources for answers.

- **Questions about God**
- **Questions about Practices in the Church**
- **Questions about Morality**
 - **The church has a responsibility to define what is right and wrong to the world**
 - **The Church in America has set its standards a little above the worlds standards, but the problem with that is that the world standards in the last generation have taken a nose dive downward and things that are sin are now acceptable in many churches. We need to once again preach repentance.**
 - **Usually when someone is asking about areas of morality it is to see what they can get away with.**

Before you answer a question it is good to determine the spirit in which it is asked to determine the motive behind it.

- Example: The Devil asking Jesus Questions at His temptation
- Example: Kids asking parents for money
- Example: Is it wrong to smoke? Social Drinking? Is Tithing a New Testament principle or is it law?

The first mention we have of infant baptism in church history was about 200 A.D. by Tertullian the great teacher, and he was opposed to it. We do not hear anything about the baptism of infants until 200 years after Christ. It gradually gained ground in the third century. Jewett says pg. 7 "The truth unquestionably is, infant baptism was introduced into the church contemporaneously with the notion, that baptism is essential to salvation. When this idea prevailed, baptism of course must be administered to infants, or they were doomed to perdition.

b. Right way to Baptize- Immersion

Acts 8:36 As they went along the road they came to some water; and the eunuch *said, "Look! Water! What prevents me from being baptized?" John 3:23 There was much water there.
